

Winners: Bhavna Bothra BBA III SEM & Runner up AnshuBothra BBA III SEM

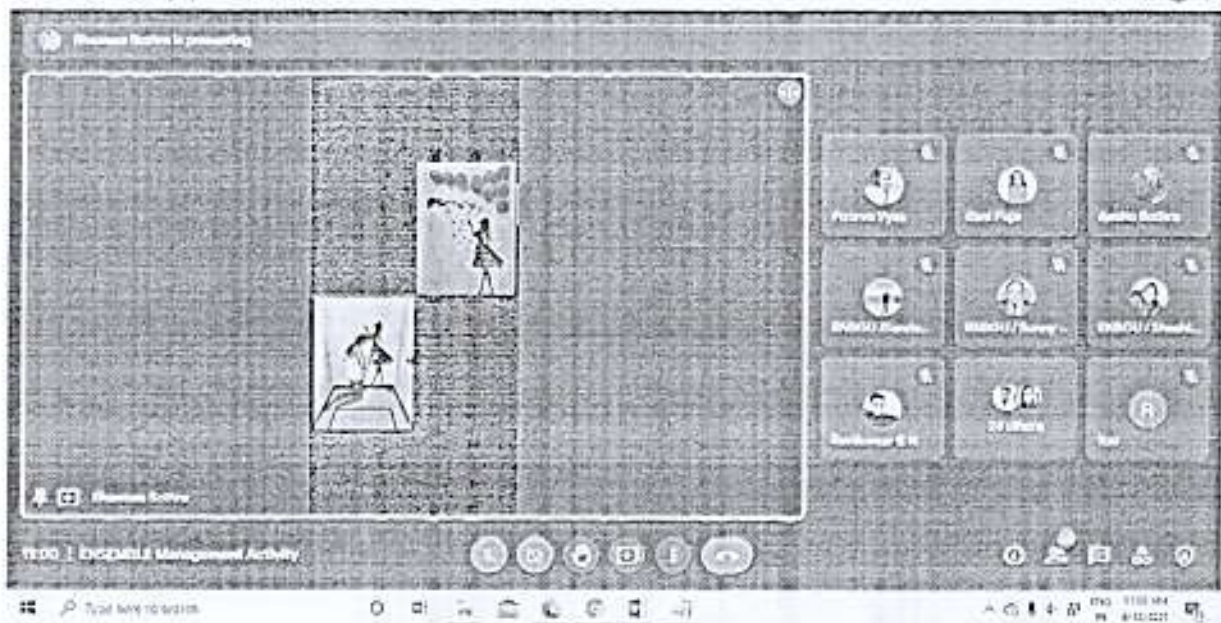
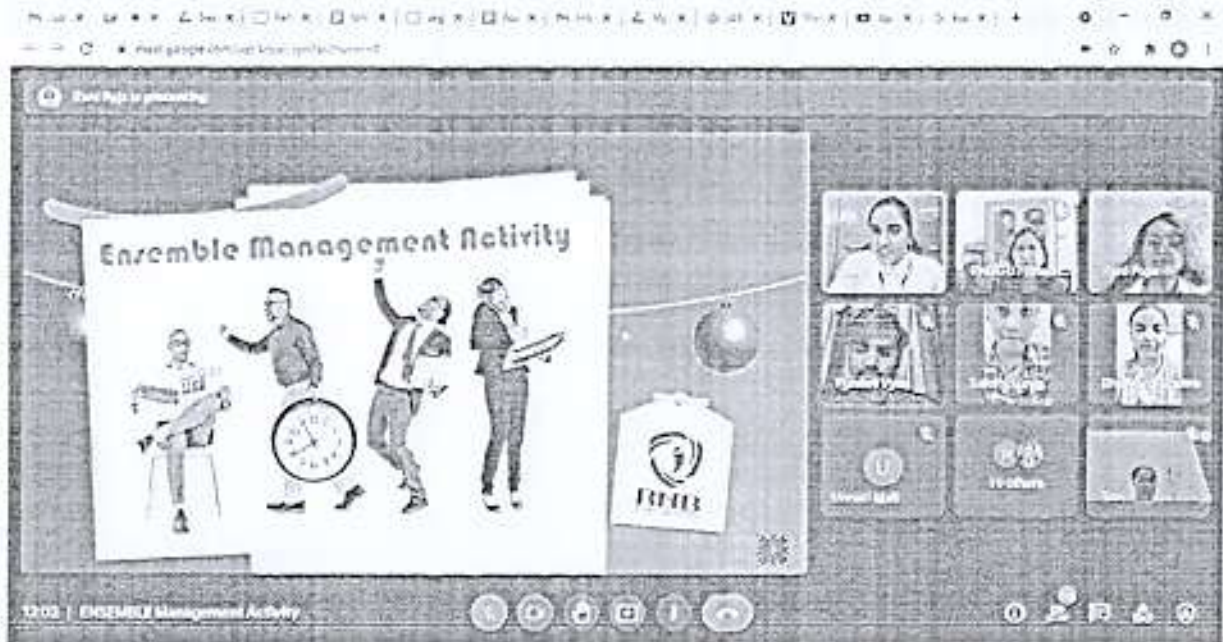

After Result Announcements, at the end of this program Dr Dipali Gupta-Registrar, RNB Golbal University given vote of the thanks.



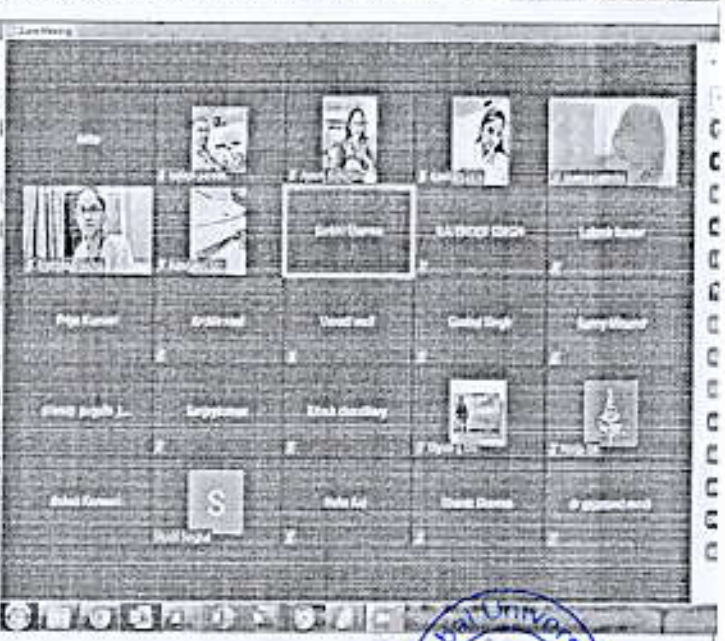
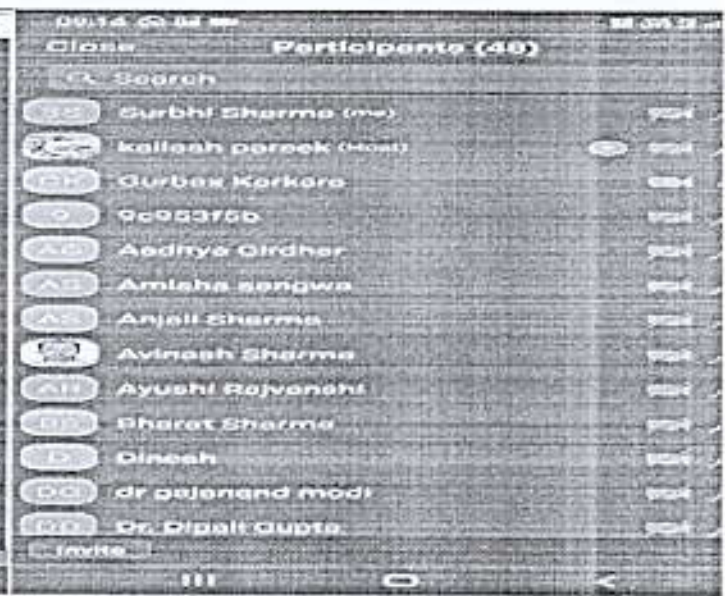
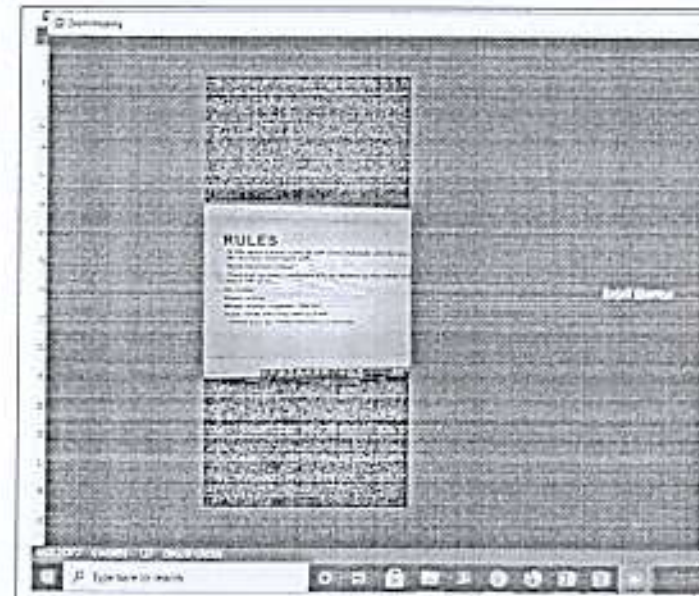

Management profession is lately being tested in the context of human weaknesses and weak structural quotient of nations. We intend to use this day to muse upon the alternatives available to managers in order to scale challenges in this VUCA world.

Hence management is pervasively vital in nature. The growth and development of our country depends majorly on the enthusiasm of youth and for that they need to know and implement the essence of management in their lives as well. Program started with **the Ice Breaking Activity** conducted for the students. This was followed by some exciting competitions like Biz - Quiz, Toggle etc wherein the students got the opportunity to show case their potential at different platforms. All the students participated in activities with much enthusiasm and energy. Some really good role plays were performed by the students on the theme assigned to them. In every activity student gave their brilliant performance, making every one enjoy the event. Both students and faculty members had fun organizing this event.

Methodology-

The event started with some ice- breaking fun activities followed by a series of competitions which culminated into deciding the Best Manager from among the participants

Events Conducted-

The following events were organised as apart of Management Day celebration-

Ice Breaking Activity- the activity was to make the participants learn some important lessons on team building and leadership through fun - filled ways.

Toggle Competition- This was to judge the spontaneity and articulation skills of participants.

Ad Mad Competition- Students showcased their skills in making advertisements for the given products.

Business Quiz- It included the rounds like current affairs, tagline identification, famous personality identification etc.

Collage Competition- Students showcased their creative skills by preparing Collage from the given material.

Role Play Competition- Participants were given various roles to play in a given situation.



Event SOP's

1. Ice Breaking Activity-Ice Breaker Games for Small Groups.

An icebreaker is an activity or game designed to welcome attendees and warm up the conversation among participants in a meeting, training class, team building session, or other activity. Any event that requires people to comfortably interact with each other and a facilitator is an opportunity to use an icebreaker.

Objectives-icebreakers are one of the most basic tools that can be used at any training event. These team-building games help foster interaction, trust and learning. These types of activities can be extremely valuable when applied to management training. The skills acquired during management icebreakers reinforce important leadership techniques with executives to help them reconnect with their teams, foster growth in their group and enhance individual performance.

2. Toggle Competition-

In this activity the students were assigned a topic in which they had to speak both in favour and against the topic within one minute. He was required to change his stand for the topic whenever the MC said toggle during that one minute.

This activity was real fun and challenge both, for the students as they had to prepare themselves to speak from both the angles regarding the same theme.

Objectives:To develop spontaneity in the students and allow them to express their ideas regarding simple topics with confidence and humour.

3. Buss Quiz

As a student of management, all the students should know about their subjects like business, finance, human resource etc. This quiz was a platform for our students to know their potential and analyze their knowledge. To boost up the confidence of the winning team and participants we have also rewarded the teams accordingly.

Procedure-The competition was held in 3 rounds. The first round was multiple choice questions round and students were asked answer to 15 questions. In the first round, 8 teams were qualified for the second round. The second round was advertising display round and students were asked to identify the products by viewing small clip of advertisement. In the second round 4 teams were qualified for the third round. The third round was logo and personalities identification round and students were presented with company logos and pictures of various personalities and they were asked to identify the same.

Objective - To encourage students to look beyond their textual knowledge and establish a relationship between theory and application of the learnt concepts and to build healthy competition among the students.

4. Ad Mad Competition

This activity involved producing and enacting creative advertisements by student groups to showcase their talent in Marketing products and services. Students will act



out on various advertisement script and ideas relevant for different sectors including FMCG products, goods, services, automobiles and social awareness etc. All the teams were given a time frame to presents their advertisements.

A team comprised of maximum 4 members. Theywere judged on the criteria like content, communication, tagline, etc.

ObjectiveThe purpose of conducting this event was to acquaint the students about the procedure of framing an advertisement. It included designing the content, logo and punchline for the final presentation of commercial.

Collage Competition

This competition is all about using scraps, papers, and colours for deriving meaningful content based on the assigned theme. The students were required to use their creativity and imagination to create a subtle yet beautiful image on a chart paper from bits of newspapers, magazines, colours etc.

Rules of Competition:

Collage must be according to theme "Emerging Issues & Challenges in Business and Economics".

Sub-themes

1. Demonetization
2. Introduction of GST
3. Global Imbalances
4. Ethics and Responsibility
5. Innovation and Change
6. Technological Development etc.

Subthemes are only for reference; students can use their own imagination to select the topic.

- Collage must be prepared on a chart paper, which will be given at the time of competition.
- Collage can be prepared in a team of max. 3 students and min. 2 students
- Collage should be made up of several different pieces, which may include paper, thread, fabric, stamps, magazine cut-outs, plastic, foil, labels, matchsticks, buttons, natural items (leaves, seeds, eggshells, seashells, etc.).
- Teams are allowed to use scissors or craft knife/blade and advised to bring their own glue, newspaper, magazines or any other material needed. Only chart papers will be provided.
- Preparation time will be 30 minutes.
- Each team will be required to make a presentation about their Collage about 5 -7 minutes.
- Collage will be collected and awarded team wise.
- Give any Topic/Proper Name to Collage on the top of Chart paper.
- Please don't write your name or course or semester on Collage anywhere.
- Separate Code No. will be given on submission of Collage for Judgment.



Objective

To give an opportunity to the students to ideate on a particular Business theme and incorporate their ideas in the form of cuttings taken from newspapers affixed on the chart papers. Such activities bring out the creative potential of the management students and makes them understand the intricacies of current business topics in all its details.

5. Best Manager Competition

"A manager is one who knows the way, goes the way and shows the way." Here was the turn of the students to go the way and lead from the front; their turn to showcase the innovation, leadership and managerial skills that they have. 
On completion of the debate, participants had given their feedback orally about how they were benefited from the program. The debate had started on 16th October, 2020 at 10.00 AM and all the judges and participants assembled at a single platform through google meet. The debate commenced on 10.00 AM after a short briefing about world food day and about the rules and regulations of the debate by Dr Ram P. Pandey. A total of 3 groups were made for a total of ten students (earlier 9 students were participating and each group contained 3 participants while one candidate (Neha Chaudhary BSc Biotech 5th sem) joined later so kept into group II). Students explained about their given sub-themes and the opponents raised their doubts/queries. A five minutes judge's Q & A slot was kept for judges in which they asked about latest innovation/findings and importance of the topics for enhanced food production.



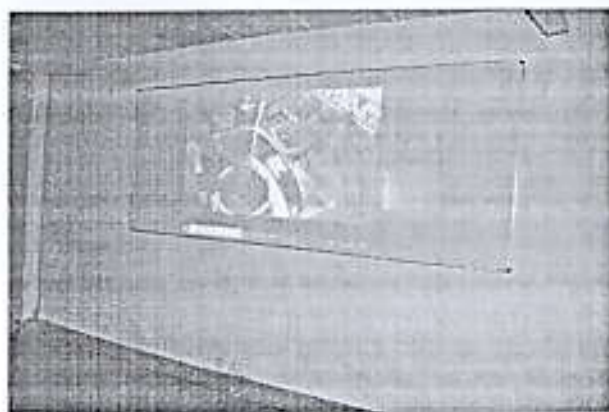
